Syllable Types

A single vowel followed by one or more consonants. The vowel does not say its name but says its sound. (short vowel). it, bet, mad. 26

The "magic e" at the end of the syllable is silent but makes the first vowel say its name (long vowel). bake, kite, snore, flute. 30

3) R controlled Syllable - vr

The "r" effects the sound of the vowel that comes before it. barn, her, for, bird. 35

4) <u>Vowel Team Syllable</u> - vv

A combination of two vowels that make vowel sounds. beat, mail, loud, snow. 36

5) Consonant - "l" - "e" Syllable, cle

Almost no vowel sound. The rule to divide these words is: Consonant "l", "e", count back three. **pud dle, cra dle, mum ble.** 47
