- 4) Spell It cards review (small white cards). 5-7 minutes
- 5) Introduction of new material
 - A. If phoneme - can be introduced while doing the phoneme cards, the Spell It cards and the Red Word cards.
 - B. If syllable division rule or affixes - follow worksheets and directions in lesson plans.
- 6) Word reading - Finger Tapping through blends and whenever helpful.
- 7) Sentence reading.
- 8) Block Spelling and Sound Spelling- 7-20 minutes.
- 19) Charades and other related games.
- 10) Independent Work (Assessment) & Homework..

Syllable Types

1) Closed Syllable - vc

A single vowel followed by one or more consonants. The vowel does not say its name but says its sound. (short vowel). **it, bet, mad. 26**

2) Magic "e" Syllable, VCe

The "magic e" at the end of the syllable is silent but makes the first vowel say its name (long vowel). **bake, kite, snore, flute. 30**

3) R controlled Syllable - vr

The "r" effects the sound of the vowel that comes before it. **barn, her, for, bird. 35**

4) Vowel Team Syllable - vv

A combination of two vowels that make vowel sounds. **beat, mail, loud, snow. 36**

5) Consonant - "l" - "e" Syllable, cle

Almost no vowel sound. The rule to divide these words is: Consonant "l", "e", count back three. **pud dle, cra dle, mum ble. 47**

6) Open Syllable - cv

The syllable ends with a vowel that says its name (long vowel). **so, bro ken, ti ger. 53**

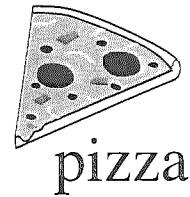
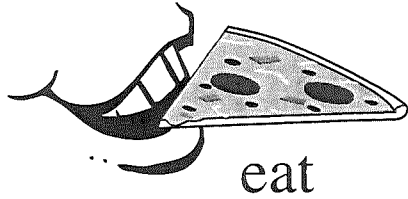
